Directions from Dane County Regional Airport:

The Madison Airport is approximately 5 miles from campus. Follow International Lane out of the airport. Turn left onto Packers Ave., which will join E. Johnson St. Bear right on E. Johnson, which will eventually fork. Bear right again onto E. Gorham St. Continue on E. Gorham for about 2 miles to Wisconsin Ave. Turn right on Wisconsin and proceed two blocks to Langdon St. (Wisconsin ends at Langdon). The Edgewater is at the intersection of Wisconsin and Langdon. If you turn left on Langdon, you will soon see The Campus Inn on your left and Lowell Hall and then the Memorial Union on your right.

To reach the Doubletree, follow the above directions to E. Gorham. Continue on Gorham, past Wisconsin, and turn left on Frances St., and left again on Johnson St. The Doubletree will be on the right.
